Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)

This program teaches skills in resident care under the direct supervision of a licensed nurse as students prepare for employment in a long-term care facility. The program meets or exceeds state requirements; therefore, students must attend a minimum of 75 classroom hours and 100 hours clinical hours. Students must be 18 years of age, meet entrance requirements, and be legally employable in a long-term care facility to enroll (not on state disqualifier list and have background check. CPR training will be included but does not count toward the 75 hours. Course fee includes textbook.

Testing dates are available on the Adult and Community Education Website: excelsior springsadulted.weebly.com or you may call 816.630.9240, option 1 for the next testing date and to request an application. Enroll at least 10 days prior to the test date. The written and skills exams require around four hours and are usually scheduled on the 4th Wednesday of the month. Check our website or call the Adult Education Office for the next available challenge exam. Dates will depend on our school district calendar and examiner availability. If minimum enrollment is not met, exam may be cancelled.
